



New Hurunui College Year 0-8 Uniform

We are changing our school uniform and the way parents/caregivers can purchase uniform items. Mainland Uniforms will now supply the compulsory Polo Shirt needed as a Year 0-8 student. They will also sell the new optional culottes and pinafore. The remaining plain navy items can be purchased through Mainland Uniform or other clothing outlets.

2019 will be a transition year to allow families time to purchase the new uniform. It will be expected that from 2020 that all students are in the new uniform. Hurunui College will be offering a \$50 (for Year 9-13 students) and \$30 (for year 0-8 students) per student uniform subsidy to assist families who need some assistance. If families wish to apply for this prior to next year, please simply send a short note to school, addressed to the Principal, simply stating the number of children and that you wish to be considered for the subsidy.

Uniform and Dress Code

Personal Grooming

Hair

- All students must keep their hair clean and tidily groomed. Hair should not be dyed any unnatural colour and no cosmetic hair permitted. Boys must be clean shaven.
- Hair ties or bands – plain navy or red.

Makeup

- Makeup and nail polish are not permitted at any level.

Jewellery

Plain gold or silver studs may be worn in the ears, and students may choose to wear either a bracelet or necklace, as long as it is not visible, and can be removed in activities where it could be a safety hazard. No rings to be worn. A watch may be worn.

Footwear

- Note: all students working in the Technology Block must wear closed in shoes for Health and Safety purposes

Sun Hats

- School cap, school bucket hat or plain navy cap allowed.

Scarves and Hats (Winter) Plain navy blue. Outdoor wear only.

Physical Education Uniform Year 7-13 compulsory.

- Approved monogrammed tee shirt available from the school. To be worn with navy shorts (no logos), white sport socks, non-marking sports shoes.

In General

Students are expected to:

- Tuck shirts in (as appropriate)
- Wear uniform socks pulled up (plain navy or white)
- Keep their uniform/clothing clean and in good repair
- Clean their shoes and fully name each clothing article.

- **Uniform for all Students Year 0-8**

- *Compulsory Item*

- **New Rugby Knit Shirt** Navy shirt with red lined collar, short sleeved, with logo (purchased at Mainland Uniform).

- *Other Options*

- **Warm Top Plain Navy Blue**, or merino jersey or polar fleece/vest
- **Bottom Half - Plain Navy Pants** (without leg zips and or labels), leggings or shorts.
- **Skivvy/Long Sleeved Thermal Plain Navy Blue** (under rugby shirt)
- **Tartan pinafore** (purchased at Mainland Uniform)
- **Tartan culottes** (purchased at Mainland Uniform)

- *Footwear*

- **Shoes** - Suitable casual school footwear or sandals
- **Socks** - white or blue
- **Sunhats**

- Hats are compulsory for Year 0-8 during Term 1 and Term 4

- Navy, wide-brimmed or HC monogrammed bucket style, HC monogrammed cap.

- *Sports Uniforms*

- **Year 0-6** - Navy shorts and polo shirt.

- **Year 7-8** - Approved monogrammed polo shirt available from the school. To be worn with navy shorts (no logos), white sport socks, non-marking sports shoes.
